Informational Items

Health Department: Cara Erwin provided the Commission with a power point presentation and gave an update on the Health Advocate Program. Assistant Director John Mooney informed Commission that currently there have been over 400 cases of Hepatitis A statewide that have been reported, 7of those cases have been in Greene County. The Health Department has provided over 475 vaccines to high-risk individuals in the county. Mooney stated there had been 11 Legionella cases confirmed in 2019 in Greene County, which is up from the usual 4 cases a year.

© 911 Director of 911 Zim Schwartz informed Commission that the office has been very busy. The 911 service board will be looking to appoint a new member in the near future as one of the board members is relocating.

Director Larry Woods explained that his staff is in there special event season and has been at the Ozark Empire Fair. OEM is currently narrowing there search for a PIO. Woods stated that they are currently helping FEMA secure a location within the county to help individuals effected by the May storms.
