# 9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting September 15, 2021

- **1. CALL TO ORDER** The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on September 15, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Six board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment.*
- 2. APPROVAL –August 18, 2021 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Williams motioned to approve the minutes; Pennington seconded. Motion carried 6/0.

#### 3. STATUS UPDATES

**Financial Reports** - The written report for the July Financials were presented by Dequty Budget Officer Tina Phillips. Revenues are 62% of budget at 58% through the year. 911 Service Charge appears to be ahead of budget; however these revenues represent receipts through 75% of the year. 911 Service Charge is still expected to be \$30,000 behind budget and Interest income is behind by another \$30,000, Sales Tax receipts are expected to make up those shortfalls. Overall expenditures were 48% of budget. Personnel expenditures were 52% of budget leaving vacancy on pace for \$547,911. Actual operations are 71% of budget. Primarily due to the annual cost of CAD system Maintenance, County General Liability, and Springfield Allocated Overhead being paid. Uniform Allowance, General Liability, Utilitities, telephone, Professional Services, Springfield Plaza TIF, Springfield Allocated Overhead, Network line, CAD system maintenance, and office supplies are ahead of pace. Capital, Debt Service & Contingency remain 27% of budget. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen Liab, Tele, Spfd All OvrHd, CAD Sys Maint, Equipment) expenses are only 46% of budget. With contingency removed Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$3,905,109 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$3,100,348 for a \$804,760 volume to the good.

Cash balance at 7/31/21 was \$3,870,346 in the warrant account. This is \$2,017,040 higher than last year. Uncleared checks at month-end totaled \$793,793. This leaves a net cash value of \$3,076,553. Net cash level is 1.85 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031.
