**No-Excuse Absentee Voting Hours  
Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>**

*Springfield, MO* - Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller reminds all voters wishing to vote absentee for the General Election on Tuesday, November 8 that no-excuse absentee voting is available **in person** for all eligible voters at the Greene County Elections Center, 1126 N. Boonville Ave. in Springfield, Monday to Friday between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm, up to and including the day prior to the election.

No-excuse absentee voting will also be available on **Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm** at the same location.

**Please note that in order to vote in-person absentee, by statute voters must present one of the following forms of photo identification:**

- A nonexpired Missouri driver or non-driver license;
- A nonexpired military ID, including a veteran's ID card;
- A nonexpired United States passport;
- Another photo ID issued by the United States or the state of Missouri which is either not expired or expired after the date of the most recent general election.
