MINUTES

Daily Briefing

Present: Barnes, Cindy Stein, Chris Coulter, Harold Bengsch, Jeff Scott, Lincoln Hough, and Kate Morris.

Resource Management Director Kevin Barnes told the Commissioner that Commissioner Todd Akins recently found nails in his car tires, which were from the construction work at the courthouse. He said it will cost \$350 for the county to replace his tires. He gave updates to campus projects, including fixing the boilers in the judicial building, courtroom construction, and utilities for the temporary jail.

Cindy Stein questioned the funding of the construction in the 10th floor of Cox Medical Tower for Commission occupancy. She asked if it was safe for her to attest to funds being available. Jeff Scott told her yes, it is; that the funds are in reserves. Scott explained different perspectives on fiscal policy as it applies to reserves. Scott and Stein decided that they will meet soon with Treasurer Justin Hill to discuss reserves.

Chris Coulter told the Commission that he and Trysta Herzog are currently preparing information to provide to employees about the proposed tax and county finances. He said many employees have been requesting educational information.
