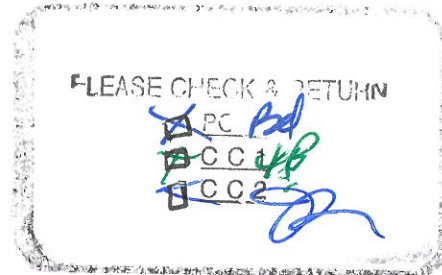

Health Department-Kendra Findley

- Hepatitis A. outbreak update. Typical year in Greene County consists of 1.2 confirmed cases. Since outbreak there have been 96 confirmed cases. 70% of cases are linked to drug use. Over 2,000 vaccines have been given at outreach clinics.
- Flu update. Expected to rise, there have been 196 confirmed cases so far. Lots of type B cases for the time of year.
- Mumps outbreak in McDonald County. Two confirmed cases in Greene County.
- One confirmed case of bacterial meningitis has been reported.


Dear Secretary Pompeo:
