Board of Equalization meetings begin Wednesday

The Greene County Board of Equalization will hold a series of public hearings Wednesday, July 13, through Thursday, July 28, to hear appeals resulting from the 2010-2011 reassessment of taxable real property.

Hearings are by appointment only. The deadline to request a hearing before the Board of Equalization was June 20. Cases before the board have already been through the informal hearing process with the Greene County Assessor's Office. Any property owner who has requested an appointment for a hearing but wishes to cancel is asked to call the Greene County Clerk's Office at 417-868-4055.

The Greene County Board of Equalization is an eight-member board of property owners appointed by the Greene County Commission and the City of Springfield. The board hears appeals resulting from new parcel assessments and property reassessments, to insure property values are entered on the county tax book at their true value.
