REMINDER: NO ELECTION TOMORROW!

Greene County Clerk Richard Struckhoff reminds Springfield voters NOT to visit their polling place tomorrow (Feb. 8). The Springfield City Primary for General City Council Seat C and Zone 3 has been rescheduled for **Tuesday, Feb. 22**, by court order due to unsafe weather conditions.

“If you find you’ll be out of the County on the new election day, absentee voting deadlines have also been extended,” Struckhoff said. Absentee ballots may be voted in the Clerk’s office on the first floor of the Greene County Courthouse (Room 113), 940 Boonville, between 8 a.m. and 4:45 p.m., Monday through Friday, until Feb. 21. Homebound or out-of-town voters may request an absentee ballot by mail. These requests must be signed by the voters and received in the clerk’s office no later than Feb. 16, 5 p.m. Mailed ballots must be voted, notarized, returned by mail, and received in the clerk’s office by Feb. 22, 7 p.m. Absentee ballots already cast for the rescheduled election will be counted on Feb. 22.

Missouri law limits the use of absentee ballots to voters who will be out of the county on election day, or who are ill or incapacitated, or for other legal reasons. Questions about absentee voting should be directed to Struckhoff’s office at 868-4060.
