Leah Betts, Collector of Revenue of Greene County, MO recently attended the annual meeting of the National Association of County Collectors, Treasurers and Finance Officers (NACCTFO) completing professional coursework in public policy administration. The conference included education courses in policy and management, offered by the Public Policy Administration program at the University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL) as part of their Chancellor's Certificate program and in partnership with NACCTFO.
