Samantha Foster Named Deputy Director of the Office of Emergency Management

SPRINGFIELD, Missouri- Samantha Foster has been named deputy director of the Springfield-Greene County Office of Emergency Management (OEM), effective Monday, Aug. 28.

While in her latest role, Foster was instrumental in enhancing the county's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), overseeing a group of 100 volunteers who are called upon to assist OEM in both planned and disaster-related events throughout the year.

A proud MSU alum, Foster sponsors the university's Emergency Management Student Association and oversees OEM's intern, volunteer and reservist program.
