Swearing-in ceremony for Greene County officials scheduled for Dec. 28

The official swearing-in ceremony will take place at 1:30 p.m. in the Historic Courthouse Rotunda, 940 N. Boonville Avenue. Ceremonies should last about 45 minutes to an hour with a reception to follow in Room 212. In addition to the official oaths of office, the day will also include a special interfaith service, which is scheduled for 10 a.m. at Stone Chapel on the Drury University campus.
