Greene County Information Systems plans network maintenance

Greene County Information Systems is asking the public's patience as they perform upcoming network maintenance.

Maintenance is set to occur from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, Feb. 17, which is a regularly scheduled holiday for Greene County. County offices will be closed on Monday for the President's Day holiday.

Public-facing services that will not be available during this time include County phones and the County website at greenecountymo.gov. Due to the website being down, services such as real estate searches, personal property online assessments and searches for marriage licenses and tax liens will be temporarily unavailable.

Springfield-Greene County 911 will not be affected.

"When performing network maintenance, especially work that results in systems being down even temporarily, we always try to pick a time that causes the least amount of disruptions possible for the public and staff, which is why we chose a holiday when offices were already closed," said Greene County Information Technology Director Jess Kerr. "We don't expect this work will take the entire day, but we put that in the schedule so that everyone can plan their County business needs accordingly."
