Greene County Highway Department continues plowing snow

The Greene County Highway Department began plowing snow at about 7 p.m. Wednesday and continues clearing county-maintained roadways today.

Greene County plows all 1,250 miles of county roadways, including arterials, farm roads and residential streets. Highway crews are working 12-hour shifts, with 32 plow trucks running during the day and 20 overnight.

Highway Administrator Dan Smith asks residents not to park on the street during the day, when residential streets are most likely to be plowed.

“Plowing around parked vehicles is very challenging,” said Smith. “We appreciate the public’s patience as we work to get all of the roads in good shape.”
