Absentees Offered Saturday Hours

Greene County Clerk Richard Struckhoff's office will be open Saturday, April 2, from 9 a.m. to

1 p.m. for anyone wishing to cast an absentee vote in the Municipal General Election.

"These extra hours are great for absentee voters who want to avoid weekday traffic," Struckhoff

said. The deadline for casting an absentee ballot in person at the clerk's office is 5 p.m. on the

day before the election. The April 5 ballot in Greene County features elections in nine

municipalities, including two ballot issues in the City of Springfield, nine school districts and

three fire districts.

THOSE VOTING ABSENTEE BY MAIL must make sure their written request for a ballot

arrives at the clerk's office by 5 p.m. Wednesday, March 30, in order to be processed. Be sure

the request is signed, states the reason for voting absentee, and contains the address to which the

ballot should be sent. State laws restrict the use of absentee voting to those who have a legal

reason, such as absence from the county on election day or physical disability. Questions about

absentee voting should be directed to the clerk's office at 868-4060.
