Greene County property tax bills mailed

The Greene County Collector's office is mailing 2010 Real Estate and Property Tax bills to county property owners this week. These bills must be paid by Dec. 31 to avoid penalties. If you don't receive your bill, you can print one online at www.countycollector.com.

Greene County Collector of Revenue Scott Payne advises property owners to avoid long lines at the courthouse by paying their bills either by mail or online at www.countycollector.com.

"These two methods of payment are the most cost-effective and least stressful ways to make your payments," said Payne. "In addition to that, the flu season is upon us and it only makes sense not to risk being exposed to the flu when it's possible to pay online or put the payment in the mailbox."

Each November, tax bills generate hundreds of calls to the Collector's Office. Payne said many questions taxpayers may have are answered on the back of their statements or online at www.countycollector.com.

"So before you call the collector and get frustrated by the heavy volume of calls our office is experiencing, please check to see whether your question is answered on the statement or online," said Payne.
