



With Halloween just around the corner, and the recent legalization of Marijuana in certain states, some parents have expressed concern over the possibility of children and teens being given marijuana edibles. While it is unlikely it is always better to be safe than sorry.

Parents should make sure that candy is in its original (untampered) packaging, as opposed to a sandwich bag filled with gummy bears, since a lot of marijuana edibles resemble more typical treats.

Parents are also advised to talk to their children about not eating anything until an adult has a chance to inspect it, as well as to take a close look at the packages themselves, since marijuana edibles are required to list THC content -- and some wrappers have been known to resemble better-known brands.

■ Did you know....

Children of parents who talk to their teens regularly about drugs are 42% less likely to use drugs I than those who don't, yet only a quarter of teens report having these conversations.
