**Red Flag Warning** remains in effect until 7 pm

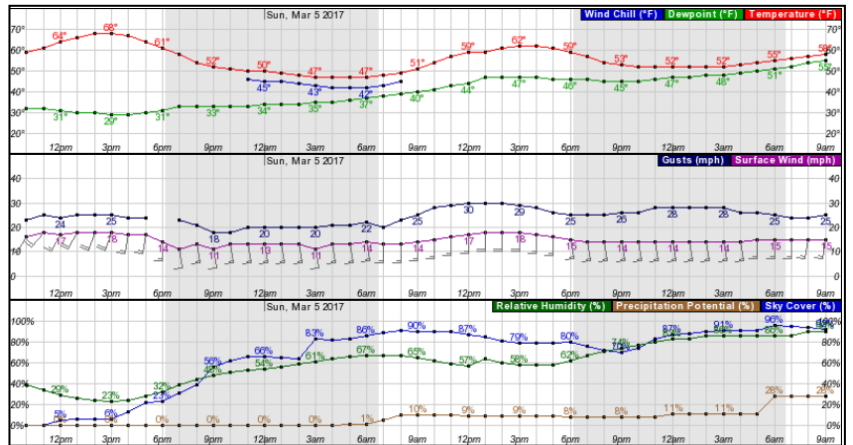
### Hazards:

Fire Weather

**Significant**

### Today's Outlook:

- **Wind:** Sustained winds of 15 – 25 mph, gusting to 35 mph are expected today.
- **Humidity:** Humidity values will range from 20 to 30 percent.
- **Impacts:** Any fires that develop will likely spread rapidly. Outdoor burning is not recommended.



### Threat Recommendations:

- Strong gusty winds combined with low humidity, dry vegetation and leaf litter will result in conditions favorable for significant fire behavior this afternoon.
- **Open burning should not be attempted due to the significant fire risk.** Open fires can quickly escape and are very difficult to control.
