## DUSTY BOHMONT SENTENCED TO SEVEN YEARS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson announces that Dusty Lee Bohmont, 37, of Springfield, MO, was sentenced today for two counts of tampering with a motor vehicle and two counts of receiving stolen property.

Bohmont was sentenced by The Honorable Calvin Holden to 7 years in the Missouri Department of Corrections for charges contained in the felony information.

At the sentencing hearing, the State requested the court sentence the defendant to the maximum number of years allowed under the charges (7 years) while the Defendant requested probation. After hearing the Defendant's criminal history and the scope of the cases at hand, the Judge agreed with the State that 7 years was appropriate.

The Defendant had previously pled guilty to the offenses that resulted from the execution of multiple search warrants on the Defendant's property in 2013. While on the property, police discovered several stolen vehicles, credit cards, identifications, dvds, amongst other stolen items. During the execution of the warrant, a separate individual exchanged gunfire with officers, resulting in one officer being grazed by a bullet and the shooter being killed.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Justin Stanek. It was investigated by the Springfield Police Department and Detective David Hatch was the lead investigator assigned to the case.
