## **Discussion:**


- What: Wet snow is expected to accumulate on elevated surfaces, bridges and grassy surfaces. This could cause slippery road conditions. Total snow accumulations of 1 to 3 inches are expected.
- Areas of Impact: Along and north and south of the I-44 corridor.
- **Other Impacts:** Be prepared for reduced visibility at times.

## Travel Issues:

**Impacts:** Hazardous travel risk is increasing from any potential snow accumulation.

**Preparedness Considerations:** Consider a winter storm kit for your car. Winterize your vehicle. Pay close attention to upcoming weather information. Watch for social media posts from OEM and our affiliated partners.
