**Current Warnings and Watches:**  
Greene County is currently under a Winter Weather Advisory until midnight tonight.

**Enhanced Weather Hazards Expected:**

Non-Thunderstorm Winds	<i>Limited</i>
Ice Accumulation	<i>Limited</i>
Excessive Cold	<i>Limited</i>

**Discussion:**

Light freezing rain and freezing drizzle is likely today and this evening over the Missouri Ozarks. A powerful fast moving cold front will cause temperatures to rapidly fall below freezing, potentially creating icy roadways. Ice accumulations will range from a trace to just a few hundredths of an inch. Sleet or snow could be mixed in. Sustained winds of 30 mph are probable, with gusts up to 40 mph possible this afternoon and evening.

**Travel Issues:**

**Impacts:** Travel may become hazardous this afternoon as any moisture on roadways may quickly freeze due to plunging temperatures.

**Options to Consider:** Consider a winter storm kit for your car. Winterize your vehicle. Pay close attention to upcoming weather information. Watch for social media posts from OEM and our affiliated partners.
