**Enhanced Weather Hazards Expected:**  
*Winter Weather Advisory* is in effect for Greene County until 6pm Sunday

Non Thunderstorm Wind Risk *Limited*  
Excessive Cold *Limited*  
Snow & Sleet Risk *Elevated*

**Discussion:**

A band of light to moderate snow will continue to move through Greene County late this afternoon. Accumulations of a dusting to near an inch expected with an isolated 2-3 inches possible. Isolated slick spots are also possible.

Overnight into Monday morning, light drizzle or freezing drizzle is possible with wind chill values dropping into the single digits below freezing.

**Impacts:** While widespread impacts are not expected, a few slick spots on the roadways will be possible this afternoon.

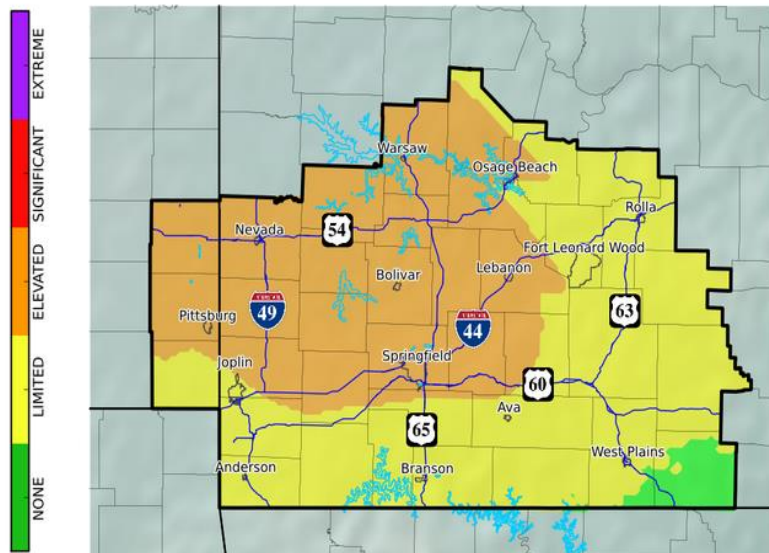
**Emergency Management Issues:**

**Snow Sleet Risk**

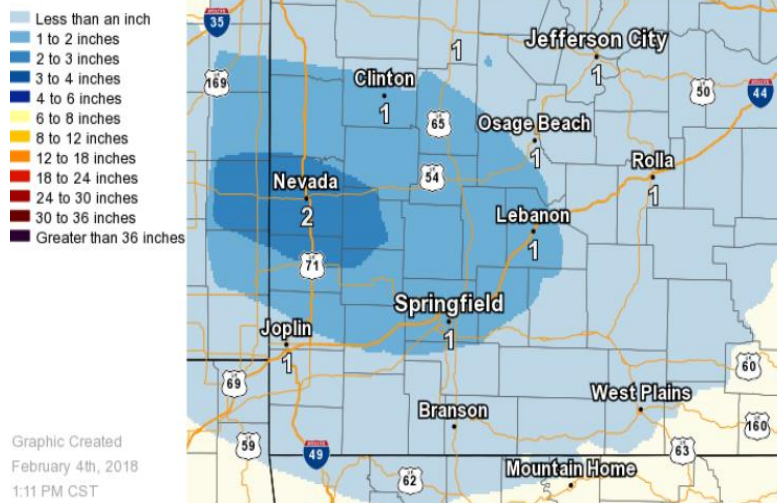
