**Weather Update:** (Springfield and Greene County): *Next update as warranted.*  
A **Winter Weather Advisory** begins at 2 pm today and goes through tonight

**Enhanced Weather Hazards Expected:**

- Snow & Sleet **Limited**
- Excessive Cold **Limited**
- Ice Accumulation **Elevated**

**Discussion:**

Wintry weather will move into the area as early as midafternoon and into tonight. Freezing drizzle, freezing rain, sleet and light snow will be possible. Snow will mainly be confined to areas across central Missouri, with a light icing and a wintry mix expected across southern Missouri. Expected ice accumulation for Greene County will be around 0.05 inches.

**Precautionary/Preparedness Actions:**

Consider a winter storm kit for your car. Winterize your vehicle. Pay close attention to upcoming weather information. Watch for social media posts from OEM and our affiliated partners.
