Current Warnings and Watches:

Flash Flood Watch through late tonight. Winter Weather Advisory through tomorrow.

Hazards:

Damaging Winds	Limited
Flooding	Limited
Lightning	Limited
Ice Accumulation	Elevated

Summary:

Freezing rain will begin impacting the Springfield/Greene County area this evening through tonight. Total ice accumulation will be expected to be around one tenth to one quarter of an inch. Locally heavy rainfall may lead to flooding along rivers and streams.

Discussion:

What: Periods of heavy rain is expected through this weekend causing flooding along low lying area and roadways. Precipitation will change to ice during the overnight hours as the cold front approaches.

Areas of Impact: The system will affect SW Missouri including Greene County.

Other Impacts: Some areas may see some sleet and snow. Precipitation will switch back to rain tomorrow continuing flooding potential.

Guidance:

- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Ice will make roads slippery and travel difficult. Plan in accordance and use caution.
- Be prepared for travel delays. Add extra time to travel plans.
- Do not drive through water covered roadways! "Turn around... don't drown."
