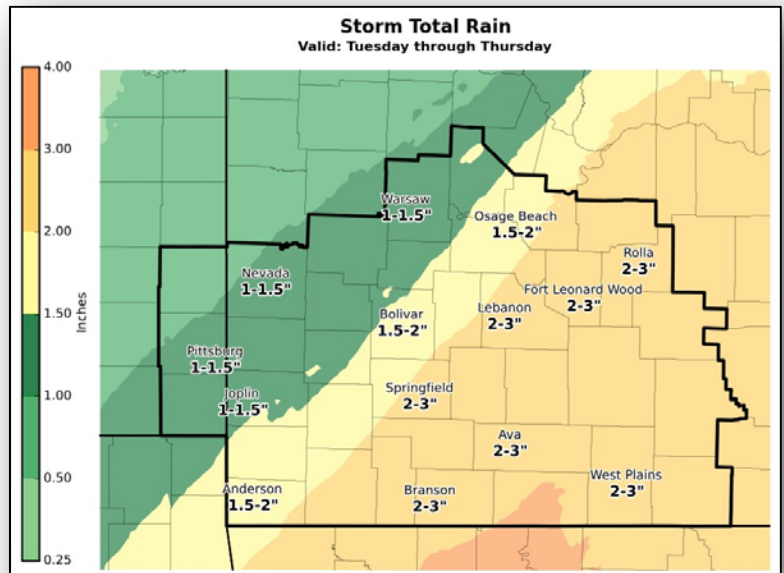
Winter Weather Advisory is in effect from 6pm tonight through 10am Wednesday and a Flood Watch is in effect through late tonight

Enhanced Weather Hazards Expected:

Ice Accumulation	Tonight <i>Elevated</i>
Flooding	<i>Limited</i>

Discussion:

Several rounds of rain through tonight may lead to some minor localized flooding. Areas that receive multiple rounds of heavy rain will see an increased risk for flooding. Smaller creeks and streams and low water crossings would be the most likely areas to be affected. Significant rises could occur on many streams and rivers if they do not flood. Rain is expected to change to freezing precipitation this evening and into the overnight hours. Current forecasted ice accumulations set at .10".



Travel Issues:

Impacts: Ground temperatures are fairly warm and will take a while to cool down. Temperatures are forecast to be in the mid 20's which will allow road treatments to work better than when the temperature drops below 20 degrees.
