**Current Warnings and Watches:**  
*Areal Flood Warning in effect until 3:15 PM*

**Hazards:**  
Flooding **Elevated**  
Lightning **Limited**

**Summary:**  
Moderate to heavy rainfall will continue to impact the area through the morning and afternoon hours with occasional minor thunder and lightning possible.

**Discussion:**  
A batch of moderate to occasional heavy rainfall will continue moving through the area later this morning into this afternoon with the heaviest rainfall occurring south of Interstate 44 (I-44). Additional rainfall amounts of 1-2" is expected to occur in areas closer to I-44.

Several low-water crossings are already flooded and additional roadways are expected to flood as rainfall moves through the area.

- Guidance:**
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
  - Do not drive through water covered roadways!
