Weather Hazards Expected:

A *Winter Weather Advisory* is in effect from February 19, 12:00 pm until February 20, 06:00 am.

Discussion:

A mixture of rain and snow can be expected to start between 16:00 and 18:00, Feb. 19, increasing in intensity as the evening begins. However, temperatures are expected to warm throughout Tuesday night. Accordingly, the snow will change to rain around 21:00. Total accumulations include 1-2 inches of snow and a glaze of ice. A chance for drizzle remains for early Wednesday morning but precipitation should stop as the day progresses.

Travel Issues:

Impacts: The primary impact will be to elevated and untreated surfaces and roadways on Tuesday evening and Wednesday morning. Expect patches of slick surfaces and reduced visibility during the evening commute.

Preparedness Considerations: Consider a winter storm kit for your car. Winterize your vehicle. Pay close attention to upcoming weather information. Watch for social media posts from OEM and affiliated partners.
