Discussion:

6/3: A cluster of storms over northeast Oklahoma will move into southwest Missouri this afternoon. These storms will then shift east, reaching the Hwy 13 corridor by 7:00 PM. **Strong to severe storms with localized wind gusts of 60 mph and 1 inch hail are possible.** Storms will continue after 7:00 PM, but are expected to weaken. **Areas of heavy rain and localized flash flooding are possible.**

6/4: Periodic thunderstorms are expected in the area for much of this week. **Some limited chances for strong to severe storms are possible Tues. and Wed.** A renewed risk for flooding may materialize. **The best chances for heavier rain and flooding appear to be Wed. night through Fri.**


Citizen Action Statement:

- Have a severe weather shelter plan! Review emergency kit and identify closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area! *"When thunder roars...go indoors!"*
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along area rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels. *"Turn around...don't drown!"*

- OEM is monitoring "WxNet" (B-15) on Greene County 800 TRS
