Discussion:

Isolated strong to severe storms are possible late this afternoon into early this evening. **Storm Mode:** Pulse thunderstorms with possible microbursts. Damaging winds to 70 mph, 1 inch hail, cloud to ground lightning, and brief downpours are possible. Additionally, localized flooding is possible with any storms that remain stationary over a location for any extended period of time, given the expected precipitation rates. Heat index values will reach the lower to middle 90s this afternoon and early evening. Additional storms will develop in a separate area across northern Missouri and move south, possibly affecting the area this evening and into the overnight hours.

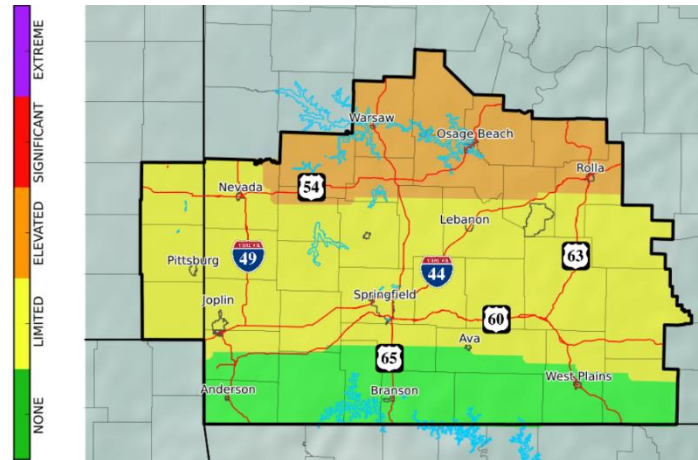
Citizen Action Statement:

- Have a severe weather shelter plan! Review emergency kit and identify closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area! *"When thunder roars...go indoors!"*
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along area rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels. *"Turn around...don't drown!"*

Emergency Management Issues:

- The Region D WebEOC Incident **"2019-05-20 Regional Severe Weather and Flooding"** will remain open through at least next Mon., June 10 due to the continuing severe weather and flooding threats this week.
- OEM is monitoring "WxNet" (B-15) on Greene County 800 TRS
- Springfield-Greene County EOC is currently at **OpCon Level 3: Monitoring**
