PROPOSITION W.G.

Shall the Board of Education of the Walnut Grove R-V School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$1.0700 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation through Tax Year 2040 in order to provide funds for the implementation of safety and security measures district-wide; the site development, construction, renovation, equipping and furnishing of new elementary school classrooms and administration offices; the development of a new drop-off/pick-up lane; the replacement of mechanical systems; and the completion of other remodeling and repair improvements to existing facilities?

If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$1.0700 from \$3.8827, currently, to \$4.9527 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for Tax Year 2020 and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter through Tax Year 2040.

Shall the City of Springfield, Missouri, continue to impose a sales tax of one-eighth of one percent (1/8 cent) for transportation purposes to fund high-priority transportation improvements, with the tax to sunset in twenty years?

(Note: There will be no increase in the current sales tax level if the one-eighth of one percent transportation sales tax is continued.)

Question 2

Shall the City of Springfield, Missouri, continue collecting the pension sales tax imposed at the rate of three-quarters of one percent (3/4-cent) for the sole purpose of providing revenues for the Springfield Police Officers' and Fire Fighters' pension system, with said tax to sunset upon the earlier of (A) five (5) years from the date of the commencement of collection of the renewed pension sales tax, or (B) the Pension System fund reaching a fully-funded (100%) status as determined by an independent actuarial study conducted for the pension system Board of Trustees?

(Note: There will be no increase in the current sales tax level if the three-quarters of one percent sales tax is continued.)
