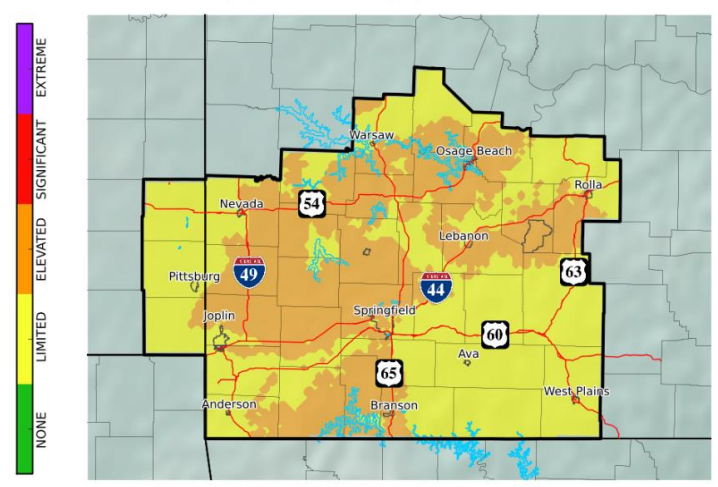
Thursday, December 12 at 1400 hrs:

- Mixing Height: 1800 ft.
- Haines Index: 4
- Transport Wind: S 23 mph
- Vent. Rate: 41,000 mph-ft

A red flag warning has been issued for parts of southeast Kansas into southwest and central Missouri through 6 PM. Low afternoon relative humidity values combined with wind gusts of 25 to 35 mph will bring about significant fire danger for these areas.
