A wintry mix will remain possible Wednesday across south-central Missouri.


### **Travel Issues**

- Impacts: Slippery roads during the morning and evening commute
- Total snow accumulation for the event is expected to be approximately 3-6 inches of snow. Total Ice accumulation of a light glaze.
