Discussion

Heavy mixed precipitation expected in the Springfield area this morning. Between the hours of 0700-0900 should be the heaviest amounts of precipitation with accumulation of 2"-3" before noon and up to an inch after noon. Possible ice accumulation of up to five hundredths of an inch.

Travel Issues

- Areas Impacted: Mainly north of and along the I-44 Corridor
- Impacts: Slippery roads during the morning and evening commute
- Total snow accumulation for the event is expected to be approximately 3-6 inches of snow. Total Ice accumulation of a light glaze.

Preparedness Considerations

Consider a winter storm kit for your car. Winterize your vehicle. Pay close attention to upcoming weather information. Watch for social media posts from OEM and affiliated partners.
