Discussion

A wintry mix of freezing drizzle and some sleet is expected mainly north of the Interstate 44 corridor through tonight as temperatures hover around the freezing mark. Some locations north of I-44 could see up to 0.10" of ice accumulation, mainly on elevated surfaces such as trees, power lines, decks, and bridges.

As temperatures cool below freezing tonight, some locations could experience a hard freeze. Additional rain and even some mixed precipitation will be possible on Tuesday.

Travel Issues

- Areas Impacted: Mainly north of the I-44 corridor
- Impacts: Potential ice accumulation on elevated surfaces and bridges

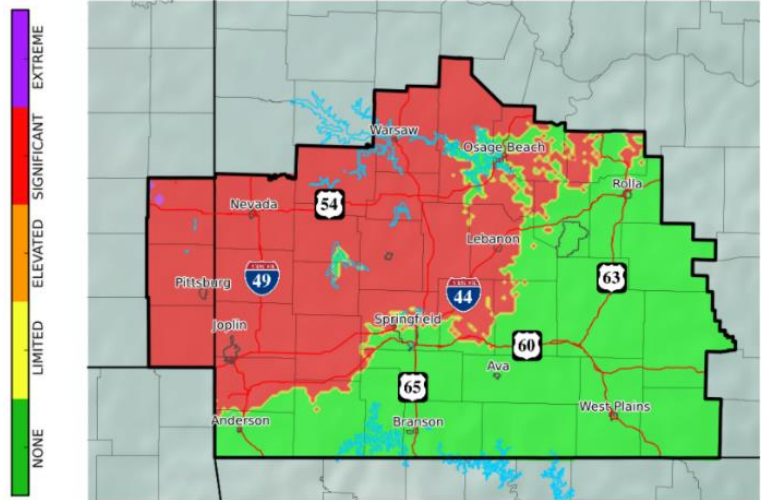
Preparedness Considerations

Emergency Management Issues

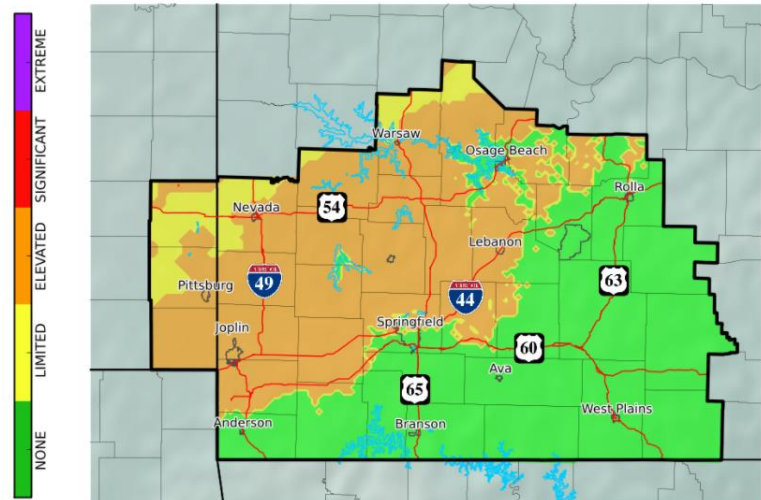
- Springfield-Greene County EOC is currently at OpCon **Level 3: Monitoring**
