Discussion

Rainfall is expected to spread northeast across the area this evening and tonight. As temperatures drop into the low to mid 30s, some snow is expected to mix in with the rain and possibly change to all snow towards morning. The snow or mix of rain and snow will likely be ongoing during the morning commute Thursday morning. There is a potential of some slushy roadways, particularly on bridges and overpasses. The best probability of any accumulating snow will be over the higher terrain of the eastern Ozarks, where up to an inch and a half will be possible.

Given the warmer ground temperatures and overnight lows in the low to mid 30s, significant impacts are not expected with this snowfall, and much of the snow will likely melt as it reaches the ground. However, given the timing being during the morning rush, caution should be used as there may be some slick areas develop from some slushy wet snow.

The rain and snow will be ongoing Thursday morning, but should come to an end from west to east during the afternoon. No other hazards are expected through next Tuesday.

Travel Issues

- Areas Impacted: Mainly north of the I-44 corridor
- Impacts: Potential ice accumulation on elevated surfaces and bridges


Preparedness Considerations
