Discussion

Southerly winds increasing today with sustained winds up to 30 mph and gusts up to 45 mph. The strongest winds will be across the Springfield metropolitan area. Rain likely with a potential for thunderstorms, however no severe weather is expected.

Widespread rain will move in by early Wednesday morning. Localized flooding of low-lying areas will be possible generally southeast of I-44. Precipitation may change over to a wintry mix with freezing rain likely late Wednesday. There is the potential for a light accumulation of freezing rain generally east of Springfield and mainly on grassy or elevated surfaces. Wintry amounts are still uncertain and could change as new data comes in.

A wintry mix may be ongoing Thursday morning before changing to all rain during the day. Flooding of typical low water crossings will be possible Thursday and Thursday night for locations along and southeast of I-44.

Travel Issues

- Areas Impacted: Springfield Metro, Southeast of I-44
- Impacts: Slick spots may develop on elevated surfaces but most accumulation will be on grassy surfaces; flooding in low-lying areas


Preparedness Considerations
