9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting December 16, 2020

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Williams on December 16, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Eight board members and proxies were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –November 18, 2020 Meeting Minutes Williams indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Moore motioned to approve the minutes; Arnott seconded. Motion carried 8/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - The written report for the October Financials were presented by Budget Officer Jeff Scott. October represents 83% of the year. Sales Tax is ahead of pace due to higher than average months. Sales Tax is 2.21% ahead of budget (\$190,000 higher) and appears to have absorbed the negative months that were affected by COVID-19. The Treasurer estimates that interest figures will be half of budget. Fees on prepaid phones are currently expected to be \$60,000 below budget. Transfers are 104% of budget and include the early pay-off of the Recovery Bond, the previously mentioned small transfer for OEM secretarial services was taken as an expense against Professional Services this month. Transfers are expected to be \$125,000 below budget. In total revenues are expected to be \$45,000 below budget at year-end. Overall expenditures were 69% of budget. Personnel expenditures were 74.88% of budget leaving a vacancy on pace to \$584,636.84, better than budget of \$400,000. Actual operations were 93.89% of budget. Uniform Allowance, Telephone, Professional Services, Dues & Subscriptions, Building Maintenance, and Office Supplies are over budget with 2 months remaining. Utilities, Springfield Plaza TIF, Network Line, and Equipment Lease are ahead of pace. Capital, Debt Service & Contingency remain 0.40% of budget. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen Liab, Tele, Spfd All OvrHd, CAD Sys Maint, Equipment) expenses are 65.4% of budget. With contingency removed Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$5,660,777.50 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$4,393,964.20 for a \$1,266,813.30 volume to the good. This is very favorable to the \$45,000 estimated decline in Revenues. Cash balance at 10/31/20 was \$2,5378,072 in the warrant account. This is \$2,181,623 lower than last year. Uncleared checks at month-end totaled \$13,128. This leaves a net cash value of \$2,524,944. Net cash level is 1.53 times of the required operating reserve level of \$1,651,109. This level is viewed to be elevated by the late processing of almost \$500,000 in expenses. When adjusted this would indicate a coverage of 1.23 times.

B. P1CAD and Statistics Update –Inman – Inman noted masking calls are receiving 4.24 calls a day. In comparison, during 2020, 9-1-1 received approximately 17 calls a day for fireworks calls. He stated the masking calls are not a burden to the dispatchers. Inman noted calls and answer times are currently below goal.
