Discussion

Freezing drizzle expected. A mix of light snow and freezing drizzle is expected over northern portions of the area.

A dusting of snow and ice accumulations of up to a tenth of an inch are expected.

Unseasonable cold is expected for several days with the coldest temperatures late this week into the weekend. Low temperatures could fall into the single digits at times, especially Thursday and Friday nights. Low temperatures near or just below zero are possible Saturday night. Wind chill values will be well below zero at times.


Travel Issues



TIMELINE OF WINTER WEATHER TONIGHT


