Discussion

Wind S 20—30 mph Gusts 35—45 mph

Humidity 20-30%

Impacts Any fires that develop will likely spread quickly

Southerly wind gusts up to 45 mph and minimum afternoon relative humidifies of 20—30% are expected across southeast Kansas, western Missouri, and portions of central Missouri. This will lead to significant fire weather conditions during the afternoon and evening.

Threat Recommendations:

Outdoor burning is highly discouraged

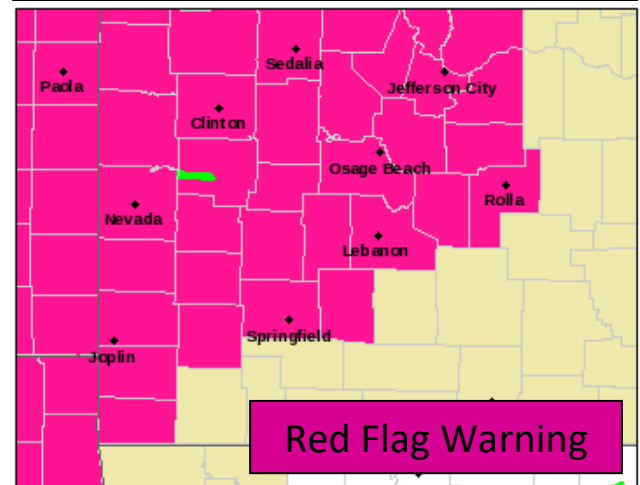
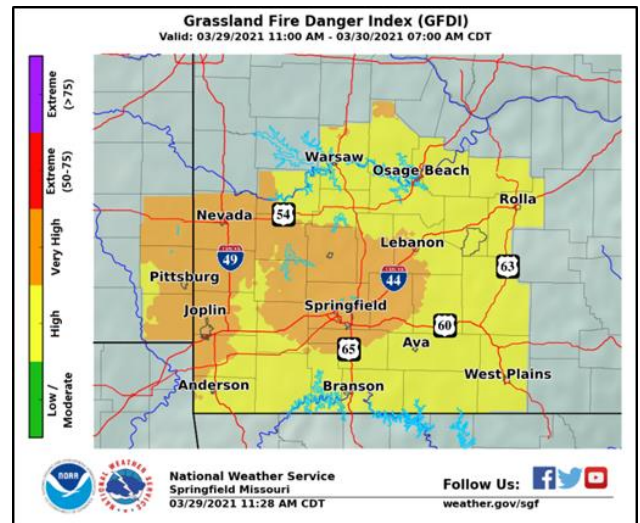
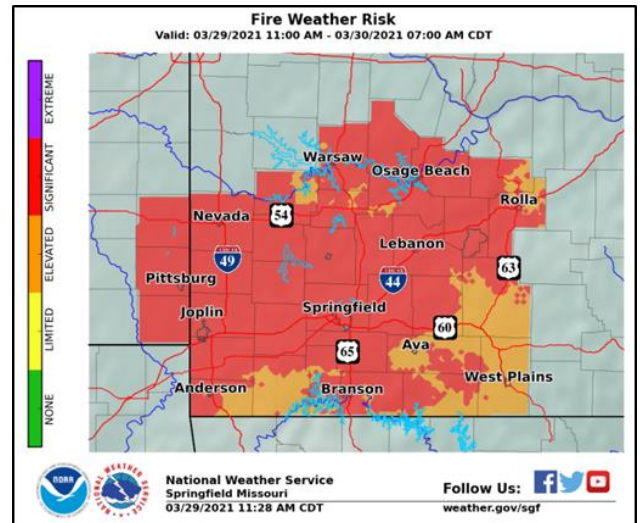
