GREYHOUND BUS STATION MURDERER CHARGED

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Dan Patterson, Greene County Prosecuting Attorney, announced that Mohamed H. Dawod, 25, has been charged today with the felonies of murder in the first degree and armed criminal action for killing Justin M. Hall. These charges stem from events which took place on September 8, 2011, at the Greyhound Bus Station in Springfield.

Mr. Patterson cautions that the charges contained in the felony complaint are merely allegations and that the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty in court.

Copies of the felony complaint and probable statement filed in this case are attached to this release. The Missouri Supreme Court ethics rules prohibit comments on the facts or investigation of this case beyond those contained in the felony complaint and probable cause statement that are part of the public record.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney T. Myers. It is being investigated by the Springfield Police Dept. and Detective Kevin Shipley is the lead investigator assigned to the case.
