Fourth Man Sentenced in Alpine Village Beating

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson announces that Davy L. Montgomery III, 35, of Republic, Missouri was convicted on April 25, 2013 by a Greene County Judge of assault in the first degree and armed criminal action. These convictions stem from events occurring during the early morning hours of January 24, 2011 where the defendant along with other individuals assaulted the victim with a hammer, gun, spear, and other weapons inside a trailer located at 7534 W. US Highway 60 in Republic, Missouri. The victim suffered serious physical injury as a result of the assault.

Yesterday, the Honorable Calvin Holden sentenced Mr. Montgomery to 22 years in the Department of Corrections for the charge of assault in the first degree and 22 years in the Missouri Department of Corrections for the charge of armed criminal action. The Court denied probation on each count. The sentences on these counts are to be served concurrent to one another. Assault in the first degree is a dangerous felony which will require Montgomery to serve 85% of his sentence before being eligible for parole.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Russell Dempsey and Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Nathan Taylor. It was investigated by the Greene County Sheriff's Office and Detective Marc Staeger was the lead investigator assigned to the case.
