2021 personal property and real estate tax statements

SPRINGFIELD, *Mo.* – Greene County Collector, Allen Icet, announces 2021 personal property and real estate tax statements are now available online at <u>www.CountyCollector.com</u>.

To pay the taxes online, citizens will need both their Tax ID number and PIN. That information can be found on their digital tax statement or mailed tax statement that will be sent out later in November.

To search for a digital statement, citizens will first need to click the green "statements and receipts" button in the top left corner of the homepage at <u>www.CountyCollector.com</u>.



Citizens will then search for their tax information by name, Tax ID number, or their address.

Finally, citizens will then click on the 2021 tax statement. This screen will also show if a citizen has unpaid taxes from previous years.

Once the citizen has both their Tax ID number and PIN they will need to click the red "pay taxes" button back on the homepage at <u>www.CountyCollector.com</u> and follow the prompts.



Citizens paying by e-check using their bank routing and accounting number will pay no additional fee. There's a 1.5% bank fee to pay by debit card and 2% bank fee to pay by credit card. All online payments will result in an immediate digital receipt available to download or print.

Citizens can also pay by mail or in person at the Greene County Historic Courthouse located at 940 N Boonville. In person payers should be prepared to wait. Lines during tax season have historically been lengthy. If by mail, address the letter like the example below:

Collector of Revenue, Allen Icet 940 N Boonville Ave Springfield, MO, 65802

Taxpayers will need to write their Tax ID number on their payment. 2021 tax statements will be mailed to the citizen's address on file and will include a breakdown of where tax dollars are being distributed. However, the best way to pay the bill is online: no stamps, no long lines, and no waiting for a receipt to arrive in the mail. Simply visit <u>www.CountyCollector.com</u>.

The Collector's Office urges taxpayers to pay as early as possible. This helps avoid issues that can arise with payments, such as checks being written for the wrong amount. Incorrect or incomplete payments will be returned. The taxpayer remains liable for any interest or penalties incurred after the tax deadline. All personal property and real estate taxes must be paid or postmarked by December 31, 2021. Payments made after December 31st will be charged a 9% penalty plus 2% interest per month.

The Assessor's Office encourages every citizen to review their tax statement for accuracy. If a citizen is unable to locate their tax statement, or has a question about the values listed on the assessment, please contact the Greene County Assessor's Office by calling (417) 868-4101 or emailing <u>AssessorOnline@greenecountymo.gov</u>. If a citizen has a question about paying their taxes, they'll need to contact the Greene County Collector's Office by emailing <u>CollectorHelp@greenecountymo.gov</u>.
