Community Survey

- ▶ The purpose of the survey was to gauge what issues community members perceived as being high priority for the county to address using American Rescue Plan Act funding. The survey provided an opportunity for the county to capture a snapshot of important issues.
- ▶ Respondents were directed to select up to 5 out of the 22 eligible ARPA funding categories listed. The 22 categories reference the 7 expenditure categories provided by the United States Department of the Treasury. Respondents were also asked to provide what part of Greene County they were from. Finally, respondents were given the opportunity to specify other community needs.

Greene County Results

- ▶ With a total of 1,717 responses, the top 10 response categories are ranked below:
- 1. **Public Health, Mental Health Services - 834 Responses**
- 2. **Services to Disproportionately Impacted Communities, Housing Support: Affordable Housing - 531 Responses**
- 3. **Services to Disproportionately Impacted Communities, Housing Support: Services for Unhoused Persons - 528 Responses**
- 4. **Public Health, Vaccination - 526 Responses**
- 5. **Negative Economic Impacts, Small Business Economic Assistance - 485 Responses**

6. **Negative Economic Impacts, Assistance to Non-profit Organizations - 418 Responses**
7. **Negative Economic Impacts, Household Food Programs - 390 Responses**
8. **Infrastructure, Broadband - 370 Responses**
9. **Services to Disproportionately Impacted Communities, Healthy Childhood Environments: Childcare - 364 Responses**
10. **Services to Disproportionately Impacted Communities, Health Childhood Environments: Services to Foster Youth - 339 Responses**

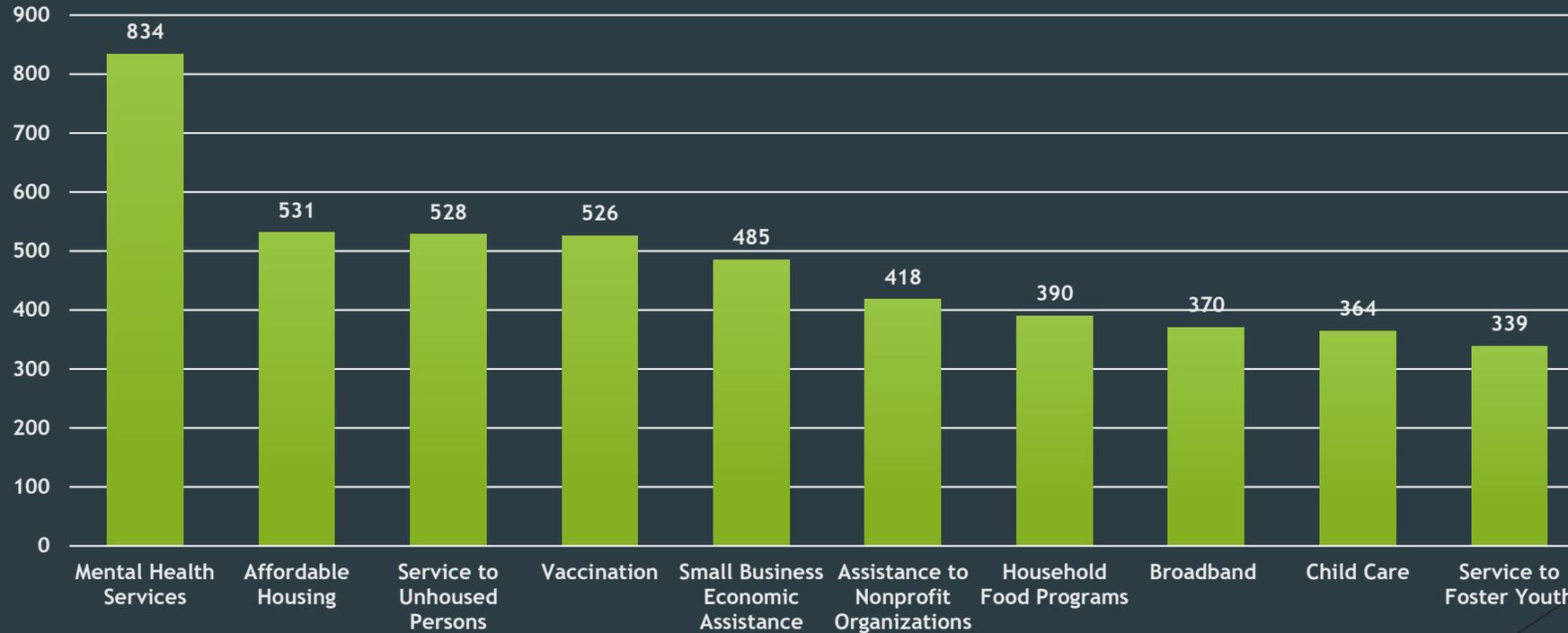

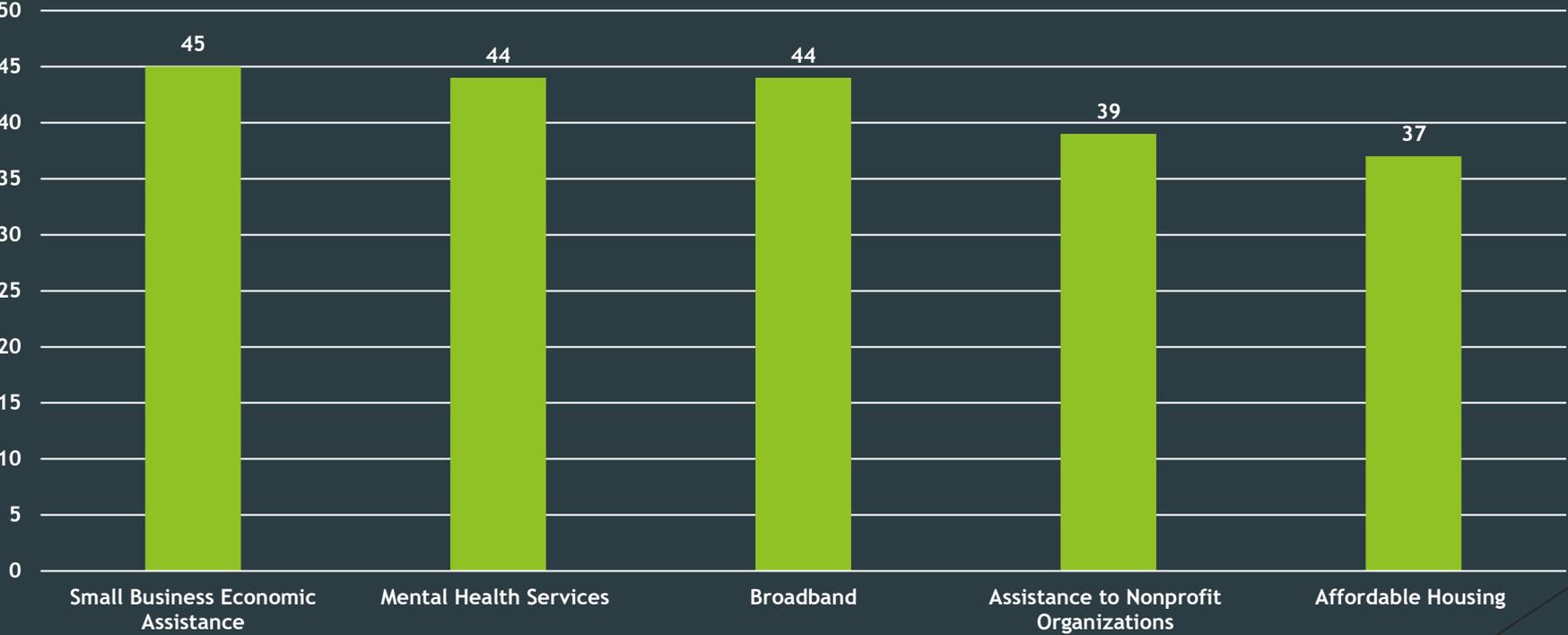

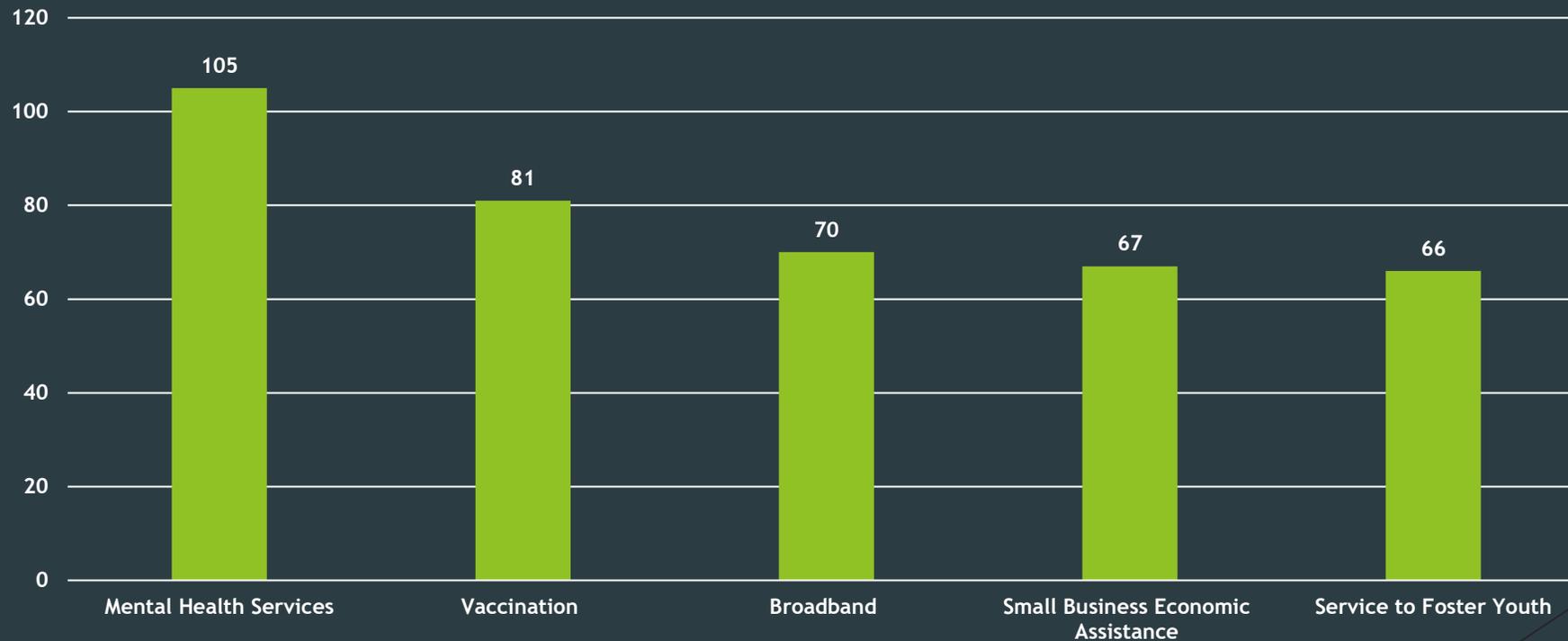
