Man Found Guilty of 27 Counts Committed During Three Month Crime Spree

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson announces that Bryan Scott Jones, 31, of Springfield, Missouri was convicted yesterday, 12/09/2021, by a Greene County Jury for crimes that occurred between February 24, 2020 and May 13, 2020.

Jones was found guilty of 27 counts contained in the felony information. The jury deliberated for a little over 2 hours before returning its verdict.

The Defendant was found guilty by the jury of 3 counts of forgery, 4 counts of tampering in the 1st degree, 15 counts of stealing, 2 counts of fraudulent use of a credit device, 1 count of leaving the scene of an accident, 1 count of resisting a lawful stop, and 1 count of driving while intoxicated.

These crimes all occurred between February 24, 2020 and ended on May 13, 2020 after the defendant led officers on a 20 plus minute pursuit through Springfield before being apprehended

The jury trial was presided over by The Honorable Becky Borthwick. Judge Borthwick set a sentencing hearing for Mar 1 2022 at 1:00PM following a sentencing assessment report by the Department of Probation and Parole.
