### Discussion

Wind W 18-21 mph Gusts 30-32 mph

Humidity 23% by 1600hrs.

Impacts Any fires that develop will likely spread quickly

Westerly wind gusts up to 32 mph and minimum afternoon relative humidifies of 23% are expected across Greene County. This will lead to significant fire weather conditions during the afternoon and evening.

### Threat Recommendations:

***Outdoor burning is highly discouraged***
