Absentee Voting Begins for August 2nd Primary Election

Springfield, MO - Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller announces to Greene County registered voters that absentee voting started today, **June 21**st, for those eligible voters who are unable to go to their regular polling place on August 2nd for the General Primary Election. In Greene County, the August ballot includes a wide variety of candidates for county, state, and federal offices, as well as issues in one city and one fire protection district.

Absentee ballots may be voted in the County Clerk's Office at the **Greene County**Archives/Elections Center, 1126 N Boonville Ave, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday

through Friday, until the day before the election. Homebound or out-of-town voters may request an absentee ballot by mail, either handwritten or from the fillable form that can be found on our website.

These requests must be signed by the voters and received in the Clerk's Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday prior to the election, July 20th. Mailed ballots must be voted, notarized, returned by mail, and received in the Clerk's Office before 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
