**Absentee Voting Hours on Saturday, July 30  
for August 2 Election**

*Springfield, MO* - Greene County Clerk Shane Schoeller announces to Greene County registered voters that in-person absentee voting will be available this **Saturday, July 30** from **9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** for those eligible voters who are unable to go to their regular polling place on Tuesday, August 2. Voters who are eligible to vote absentee will be able to visit the Greene County Elections Center at 1126 N. Boonville Ave. in Springfield or the Office of the County Clerk in the Historic Courthouse, Room 113. Voters who plan to vote absentee are reminded to please be sure to bring a valid form of identification. Absentee voting hours will also be available from **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** on **Monday, August 1.**
