# 9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting February 16, 2022

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on February 16, 2022 at 3:01 p.m. via phone conference call. Six board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –January 19, 2022 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Arnott motioned to approve the minutes; Woods seconded. Motion carried 6/0.

## 3. STATUS UPDATES

**Financial Reports** - The written report for the December Financials were presented by Budget Officer Jeff Scott. Revenues are 114% of budget for the year. Sales tax receipts and an unbudgeted State Grant account for the majority of the delta. Overall expenditures were 86% of budget. Personnel expenditures were 91% of budget leaving vacancy on pace for \$502,588 after planned vacancy of \$275,000.Nine accounts were over budget by a total of \$34,649.97, while eight accounts were under budget by a total of \$180,618.64. Misc Equipment Maintenance was the chief difference being \$129,877.20 under budget. Capital, Debt Service & Contingency remain 27% of budget. With contingency removed Overall Budget is \$6,752,624.44 and Overall Spending is \$6,011,124.30 for a \$741,500.14 volume to the good.

Cash balance at 12/31/21 was \$4,532,010.72 in the warrant account. This is \$2,153,788 higher than last year. Uncleared checks at month-end totaled \$405,349. This leaves a net cash value of \$4,126,662. Net cash level is 2.48 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031.

2022 required operating reserve level is \$1,708,605. 2022 budget projects additional cash position growth of \$1,280,656. This indicates an ending 2022 cash position of \$5,407,318. This is \$3,698,713 higher than the required operating reserve level. The Budget Department recommends, that the advisory board considers recommending to Commission, reasoning for a specific equipment and/or building reserve set-aside of up to \$1,850,000. (Not quite 45% of current net cash and close to half of the projected 2022 net cash after operating reserve amount.)
