# 9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting April 20, 2022

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on April 20, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Six board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL February 16, 2022 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Schrader motioned to approve the minutes; Quigley seconded. Motion carried 6/0.

## 3. STATUS UPDATES

**Financial Reports** - Financial Reports - The written report for the February Financials were presented by Deputy Budget Officer Tina Phillips. February represents 17% of the year. Sales tax is at 16.65% of budget with 911 Service Charge at 23% and Investment Interest at 93.75%. Overall, revenue is on pace to meet budget. Personnel expenditures were 15% of budget leaving vacancy outpacing budget by \$53,031.27. Operations are 5.1% of budget with office supplies ahead of pace at almost 37%. Capital, Debt Service & Contingency are showing no activity. Overall total expenditures are 12.12%. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen Liab, Tele, Spfd All OvrHd, CAD Sys Maint, Equipment) expenses are 12.97% of budget. With contingency removed, Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$1,087,898.99 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$898,446.17 for a \$189,452.82 volume to the good.

Cash balance at 2/28/22 was \$5,483,130 in the warrant account. This is \$2,371,687 higher than last year. Net cash level is 3.29 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031.
