9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting June 15th, 2022

- CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on June 15th, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Eight board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –May 18th, 2022 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Denison motioned to approve the minutes; Schrader seconded. Motion carried 8/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - Financial Reports - The written report for the April Financials were presented by Deputy Budget Officer Tina Phillips. April represents 33.33% of the year. Sales tax is at 33.05% of budget with 911 Service Charge at 44.11% and Investment Interest exceeding well over budget at 1,989.49%. Overall revenue is coming in just slightly ahead of budget at 33.88%. Personnel expenditures were 33.24% of budget, compared to 34.6% for 9 of 26 pay periods, projecting vacancy to be 210,897 better than budget of \$275,000. Operations are 48.29% of budget with telephone, CAD Systems Maintenance, and office supplies ahead of pace. Capital, Debt Service and Contingency are at 62.23% with Equipment coming in at 104%. Overall, total expenditures are 38.24%. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen.Liability, Telephone, Spfld All OvrHd, CAD System Main, Equipment), expenses are 22% of budget. With contingency removed, Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$2,378,327.64 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$1,830,674.24 for a \$547,653.40 volume to the good.

Cash balance at 4/30/22 was \$6,040,785 in the warrant account. This is \$2,404,482 higher than last year. Net cash level is 3.6 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031.
