9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting October 19, 2022

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on October 19, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Five board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –September 21, 2022 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Denison motioned to approve the minutes; Schrader seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - The written report for the August Financials were presented by Deputy Budget Officer Tina Phillips. August represents 67% of the year. Sales tax is at 81.49% of budget with 911 Service Charge at 67.24% and Investment Interest exceeding well over budget at 2,562,7%. Overall revenue is coming in ahead of budget at 81.9%. This is currently \$1,936,298 ahead of pace. Personnel expenditures were 63.8% of budget, compared to 69.2% for 18 of 26 pay periods with projected vacancy to be 417,869 better than budget of \$275,000. Operations are 71.6% of budget with general liability, utilities, Springfield allocated overhead, CAD system maintenance, office supplies and building maintenance ahead of pace. Capital, Debt Service and Contingency are at 63.7% with equipment coming in at 106.3%. Overall, total expenditures are running slightly below pace at 65.1%. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen.Liability, Telephone, Spfld All OvrHd, CAD System Main, Equipment), expenses are 60.6% of budget. Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$4,919,952 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$4,345,078 for a \$574,874 volume to the good through 8 months.

Cash balance at 8/31/22 was \$6,455,228 in the warrant account. This is \$2,792,633 higher than last year. Net cash level is 3.45 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031. Budgeted Revenues are \$1,034,156 higher than Budgeted Expenditures.
