9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting November 16, 2022

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Moore on November 16, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. via phone conference call. Five board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –October 19, 2022 Meeting Minutes Moore indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Williams motioned to approve the minutes; Pennington seconded. Motion carried 5/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - The written report for the September Financials were presented by Deputy Budget Officer Tina Phillips. September represents 75% of the year. Sales tax is at 91% of budget with 911 Service Charge at 67.24% and bank interest at 62% of budget. Overall revenue is coming in ahead of budget at 91%. This is currently \$1,338,380 ahead of pace. Personnel expenditures were 75% of budget, compared to 77% for 20 of 26 pay periods with projected vacancy to be 131,416 better than budget of \$275,000. Operations are 76% of budget. Capital, Debt Service and Contingency are at 64%. Overall, total expenditures are barely below pace at 74%. When making adjustments for one-time expenses (Gen.Liability, Telephone, Spfld All OvrHd, CAD System Main, Equipment), expenses are 70.7% of budget. Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$5,483,925 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$5,073,214 for a \$410,711 volume to the good through 9 months.

Cash balance at 9/30/22 was \$6,573,191 in the warrant account. This is \$2,381,687 higher than last year. Cash level is 3.71 times the required operating reserve level of \$1,665,031.
